Creation Care Sunday Trash Talk - Cake!?

Sunday, April 21, is 'Welcome Pastor Korla Sunday', so what do we do when we have cake??

- Specially purchased paper plates (Chinet brand) are BPI certified and compostable (same as coffee cups/sleeves)
- 2. Colored Napkins Per Rachel Lindholm, Richfield Sustainability Specialist, all napkins are compostable unless they have glitter or metallic foil on/in them. Color and printing do not matter! Napkins, paper towels, egg cartons, and pizza boxes do not need to be BPI-certified (and you usually will not find any certification on those products anyway).
- 3. Leftover Cake/excess frosting (hahaha!) Organics (as if there will be any!)
- 4. Name tags (go in the trash)

Creation Care — Earth Day
On April 22 we celebrate Earth Day in
the United States and in nearly 193
countries around the world. The
theme chosen for this year is Planet
vs. Plastics, and organizers are
asking all to be mindful of plastic
waste, and do what they can to reduce
their usage of single-use plastics. Put
simply, single-use plastics are goods
that are made primarily from fossil
fuel—based chemicals



(petrochemicals) and are meant to be disposed of right after use—often, in mere minutes. Single-use plastics are most commonly used for packaging and service ware, such as bottles, wrappers, straws, and bags. 91% of plastics are not recycled at all.

Visit our table display in the Narthex on Sunday, April 28, between services. Here are some easy ideas to get you started:

- * Carry a reusable water bottle (and bring your own coffee cup to HOP)
- * Bring reusable totes or last trip's paper bags when shopping (pick up a HOP reusable bag on the 28th-while supplies last!)
- * Avoid plastic or Styrofoam clam-shell take out/take home containers
- * Request that your favorite restaurants use non-plastic straws, stirrers, bags

* Don't use plastic wrap (silicone bowl covers are available)

Enthusiasm measures our being alive and there is plenty of that here at Mount Olivet Adult Day Services.


Programming includes opportunities to hear a poem, sing a song, hug a friend, dance, and play a game; all in one glorious morning or afternoon!
